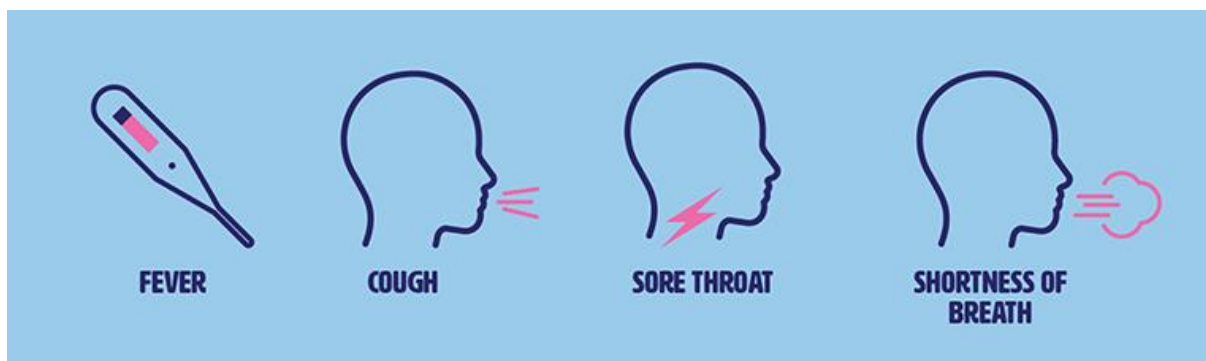
Covid-19 Policies and Procedures

Covid-19 Policies and Procedures

Geelong Sports Hub continues to monitor and follow the latest advice regarding coronavirus (COVID-19). Patrons are required to follow the below policies and procedures to ensure the safety and wellbeing of everyone. These have been created and implemented to significantly reduce the transmission of Covid-19 in the sporting community. Consequences apply to any person who does not adhere to the below policies and procedures.

If you are experiencing any of the below symptoms, please do not enter the stadium and seek professional advice



Patrons during casual shooting:

- Required to wear a mask when not on the court
- Bookings are required for casual shooting via <https://geelongsportshub.skedda.com/booking>
 - MAX of 2 people per ring
 - Both people are to enter detail when booking
 - Sessions are 50 minutes to allow for cleaning procedures
 - Patrons are to arrive no more than 5 minutes before their booking
- Sign into the stadium upon entry via QR code or sign in sheet
 - If you have booked via Skedda for casual shooting you will not need to sign in as we have a record of your details.

- Sanitise hands and ball upon entry and exit of the stadium
- Physical distancing applies
 - o 1.5m physical distancing
 - o This includes **NO** one-on-one for seniors until further notice
- All payments are now cashless
- Abide by signage that states maximum capacity for an area
- Drinking fountain is not operational

Patrons during competitions:

- Required to wear a mask when not on the court
- Arrive no more than 10 minutes before game
- Wait outside the stadium until confirmation from an employee to enter
- Sign into the stadium upon entry via QR code or sign in sheet
- Sanitise hands and ball upon entry and exit of the stadium
- Team go directly to appropriate court
 - o Team managers complete log in process via computers upon entry and pays match fee
 - o All payments are now cashless (via EFTPOS, Teammo or Bulk Bills)
- All patrons and players are required to be “ready to take the court” upon entry
 - o For players this means being fully dressed in correct shoes and uniform
- Physical distancing applies
 - o 1.5m physical distancing throughout the entire stadium
 - o Patrons are to be seated 1.5m apart in the designated seating areas
 - o Abide by floor markings
- Abide by signage that states maximum capacity for an area
- Drinking fountain is not operational

Geelong Sports Hub venue:

- Courts, toilets, seating, benches, computers, scoring tablets and table surfaces are cleaned every morning.

- Seats, benches, tablets, login screens, balls and scoreboard controls are sanitised before each game/booking.
- All employees are required to wear a mask and disposable gloves for the duration of their shift.
- Employees are required to maintain 1.5m physical distancing from each other and patrons at all times.
- All side doors to the stadium are opened to ensure air circulation.

Employees are required to abide by the Geelong Sports Hub COVIDSafe Plan until further notice.
